The Knight's Toolkit

Five rules every Knight remembers — print this and put it somewhere you'll see it.

1

Names, school, and address stay offline

Nice people online don't need your real name, school, or where you live to keep talking to you.

2

Passwords are secrets — even from friends

Never share a password with anyone, no matter how well you know them.

3

Urgency and secrecy are red flags

If a message rushes you or asks you to keep a secret from your parents, stop and tell a trusted adult.

4

No in-person meetups without a trusted adult

Never meet someone from online in person without a parent knowing exactly where, when, and who with.

5

Telling a trusted adult is never the wrong move

If something feels off, or something already happened, tell someone. You won't be in trouble for telling.
